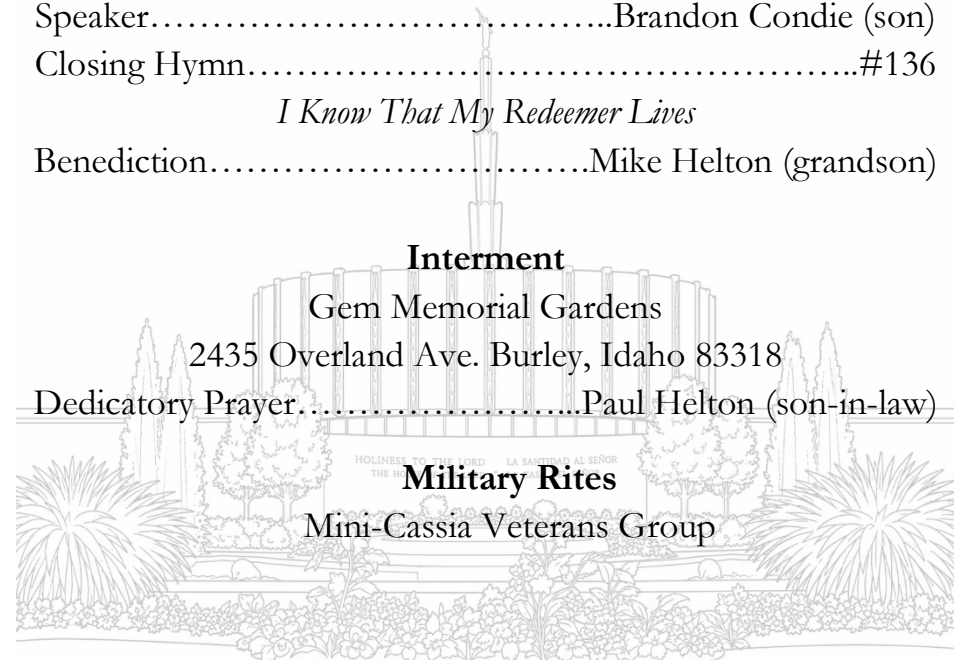

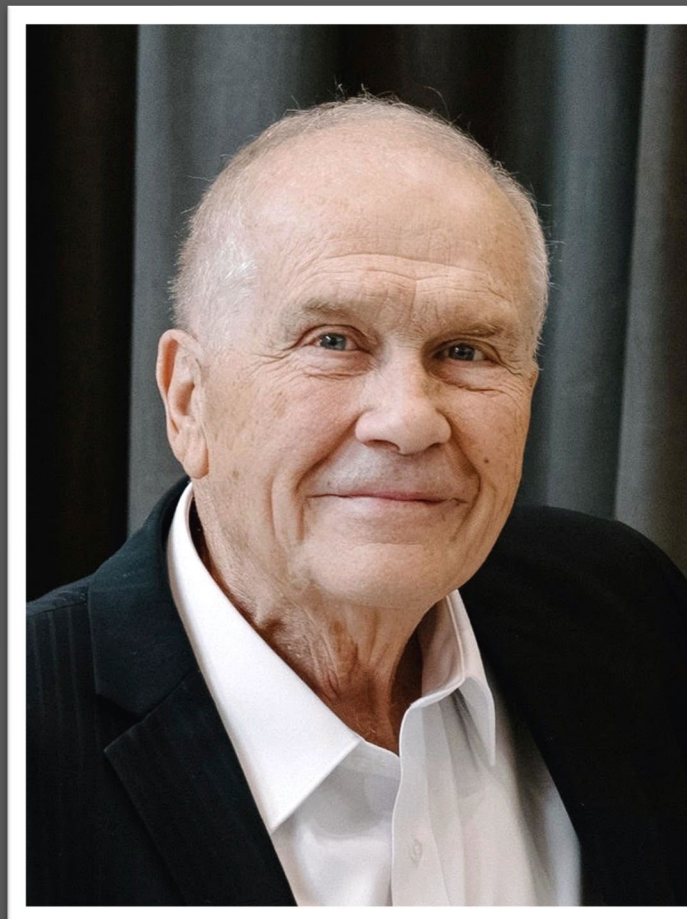
Families Can Be Together Forever
